

BLUFFTON TOWN COUNCIL EMERGENCY MEETING MINUTES
OCTOBER 12, 2016

Mayor Lisa Sulka called the meeting to order at 4:35 p.m. Council members present were Mayor Pro Tempore Larry Toomer, Fred Hamilton, Harry Lutz and Dan Wood. Deputy Town Manager Scott Marshall, Director of Growth Management Heather Colin were also in attendance. Town Attorney Richardson LaBruce was conferenced in via phone.

Consideration of an Emergency Ordinance Pursuant to S.C. Code Ann. Section 5-7-250 and Section 2-18 of the Town Code, Vesting the Town Manager with Certain Powers Upon the Declaration of a State Emergency Within the Town of Bluffton and Activating the Emergency Powers of the Town Manager- Scott Marshall, Deputy Town Manager :

Scott Marshall gave an overview regarding the ordinance, which vests certain authority and powers with the Town Manager during a State of Emergency to implement measures necessary to facilitate the protection of life and property, as well as to expedite the recovery process. The ordinance will expire on the 61st day following its adoption or at the end of the declared State of Emergency.

Hamilton moved to approve an Emergency Ordinance Pursuant to S.C. Code Ann. Section 5-7-250 and Section 2-18 of the Town Code, Vesting the Town Manager with Certain Powers Upon the Declaration of a State Emergency Within the Town of Bluffton and Activating the Emergency Powers of the Town Manager. Toomer seconded. The motion carried unanimously.

Mayor and Council requested that there be a monthly update of status of the Emergency Ordinance on the Executive Session Agenda until such time that it expires.
