Hurricane Debris Dumpster to Be Removed from Oyster Factory Park

The Town of Bluffton will remove its courtesy storm debris dumpster from Oyster Factory Park December 30.

Debris dumpsters were provided at three locations after Hurricane Matthew to help residents dispose of their storm debris. The dumpsters at Eagles Field and Oscar Frazier Park have already been removed.

“The Town felt providing these dumpsters were a sound investment in the community clean-up effort,” Deputy Town Manager Scott Marshall said. “As use of these dumpsters has significantly diminished since Hurricane Matthew, we feel the timing is right to have the last of the dumpsters removed.”

Residents have until Friday, December 30 to use the remaining debris dumpster at Oyster Factory Park. As an alternative, residents can also dispose of storm debris at select Beaufort County Convenience Centers.
