Temporary Road Closures Scheduled Due to May River Road
Streetscape Project & Sewer Installation

Portions of May River Road and Pin Oak Street will be closed during the next month as construction continues on the May River Road Streetscape Project and Jason-Able Sanitary Sewer Project.

- Pin Oak Street in the Bluffton Park neighborhood will be closed between Brendan and Kerby Lanes starting Wednesday, August 23 through Friday, August 25 as Beaufort Jasper Water Sewer Authority installs water and sewer main lines. Able Street and 4th Avenue will be open and will be used as detours. Bluffton Park and adjacent neighborhoods will be fully accessible with detours.
- During the week of August 21, Preferred Materials, the Town's contractor, will be working west of the Dollar General to install storm drainage pipes. Nighttime closures are expected Wednesday, Thursday and Friday. This construction, which is a part of the May River Road Streetscape project, will require short detours as portions of May River Road will be closed. The majority of construction will happen at night, however, there will be a few daylight shifts needed. Please be mindful of detour signs, flag personnel and construction zones.
- During the week of August 28, Preferred Materials will be installing drainage pipes across May River Road at the Pin Oak Street intersection. This construction is also a part of the May River Road Streetscape. This will require the entrance of Pin Oak Street to be closed for a few days. Construction crews will be installing drainage pipes and connecting them to the storm drainage manhole which is located in the center of Pin Oak Street.

The Town of Bluffton staff members and contractors are dedicated to minimizing inconveniences to drivers and residents during this construction.
