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Town of Bluffton Request Feedback for 68 Boundary Street Park/Parking Area Design Plan
Preview of Plans/DuBois Park/Saturday, March 31

Town leaders and staff members invite the public to preview and provide feedback for two conceptual designs for the park/parking area at 68 Boundary Street.

When: Saturday, March 31, 2018/10 a.m. – 2 p.m.

Where: DuBois Park Pavilion

What: Preview and provide feedback for two design concept options for the proposed park and parking area at 68 Boundary Street.

The first design is comprised of 73 parking spaces with 0.5 acres of open space. The second design is comprised of 69 parking spaces with 0.76 acres of open space. The proposed parking areas will be staked out on-site so residents can visualize the difference between the two design plans.

About 68 Boundary Street Property:

The Town of Bluffton acquired the 1.47 acre parcel of land at 68 Boundary Street in early October. Located between Dubois Park and the Bluffton Historical Preservation Society's Heyward House, the property will be utilized as public open space and will provide additional public parking spaces in the Bluffton Historic District.
