Bush Lane Shooting Arrest

Bluffton Detectives have arrested 19-year-old D’Kendrick Knight for Attempted Murder and Possession of a Weapon during the Commission of a Violent Crime.

Knight is accused of shooting 33-year-old Thomas Bush multiple times on Bush Lane on November 8, 2019 just before 5 p.m.

Throughout the investigation it was determined Knight and Bush were arguing before Knight allegedly shot Bush.

“This arrest is the result of the partnership between the Bluffton Police Department and the 14th Circuit Solicitor’s Office. Bluffton detectives and intelligence unit, along with guidance from the Solicitor’s Office made this arrest possible, and as a result, made Bluffton streets safer,” said Bluffton Police Chief Chris Chapmond.

After Knight was arrested, he was transported to the Beaufort County Detention Center.
