



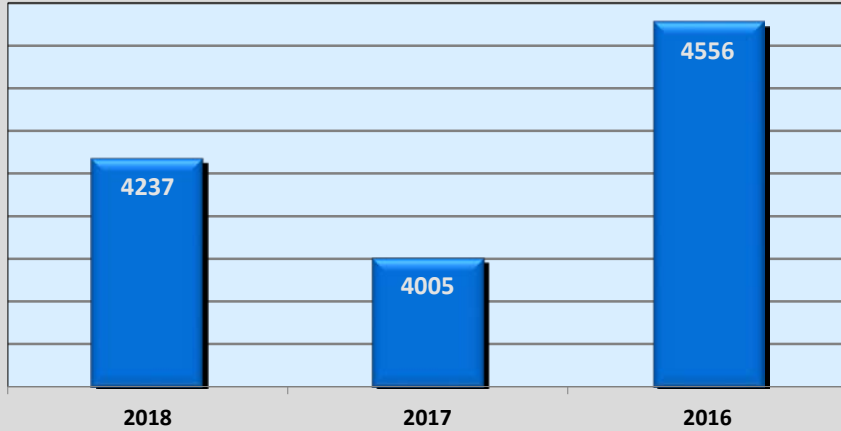

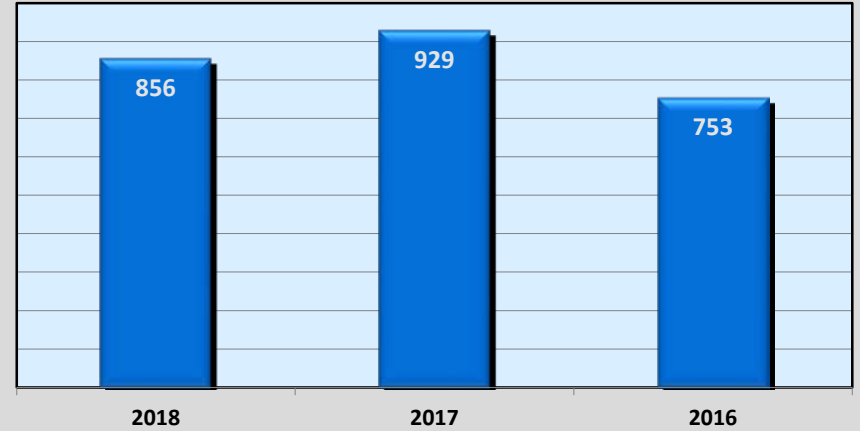

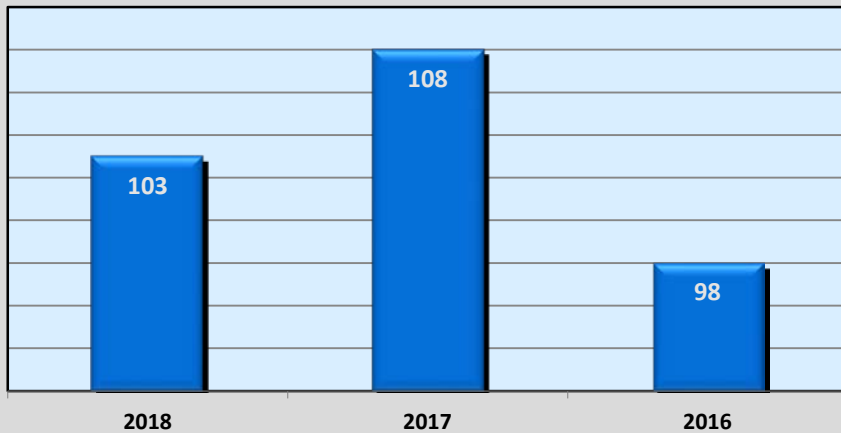
May Calls for Service Comparison



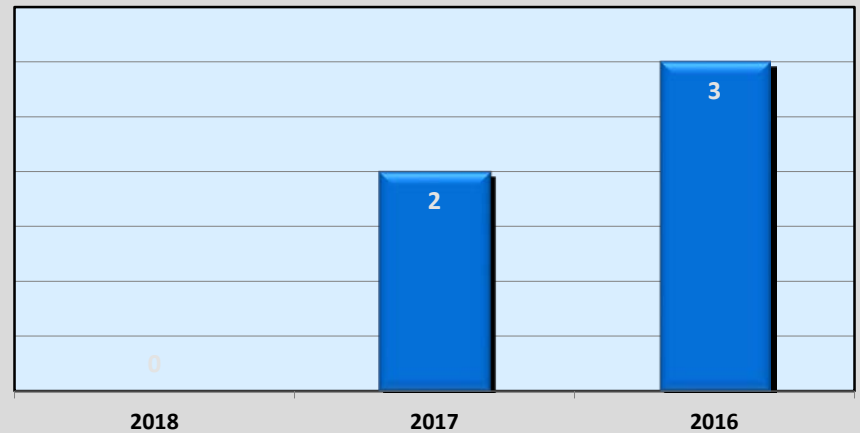
May Traffic Citation Comparison



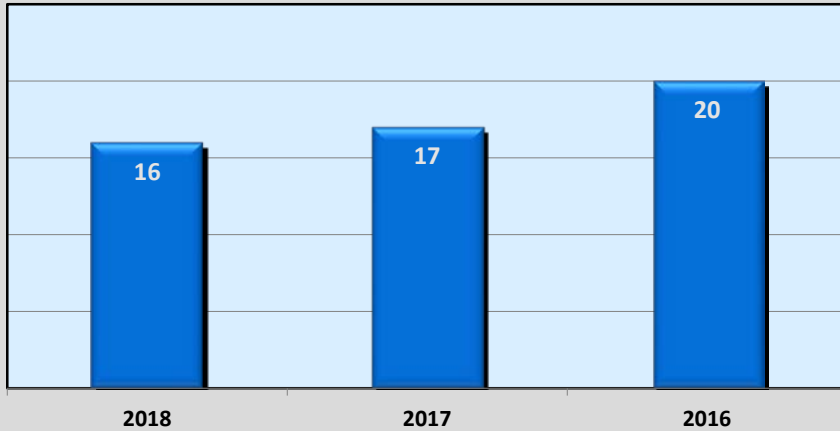
May Collision Comparison



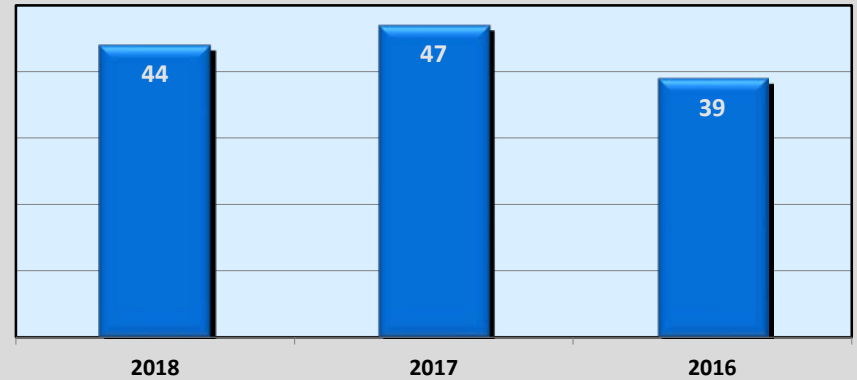

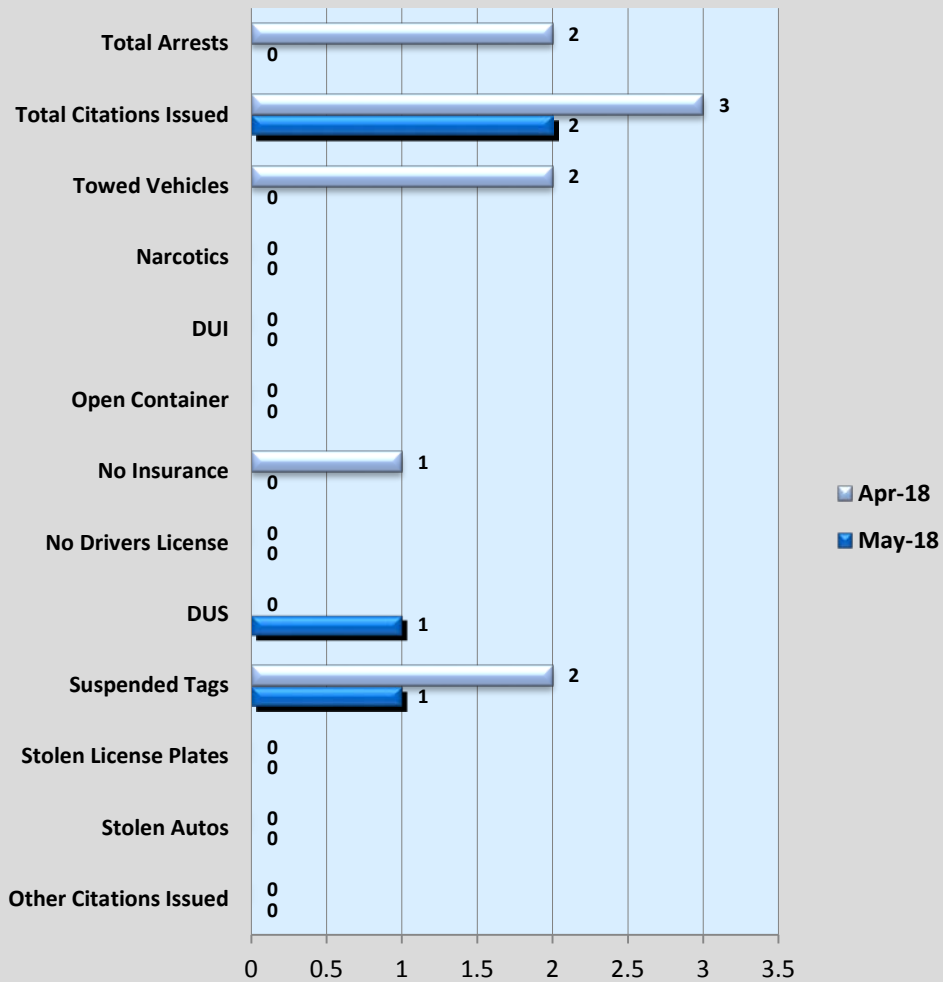

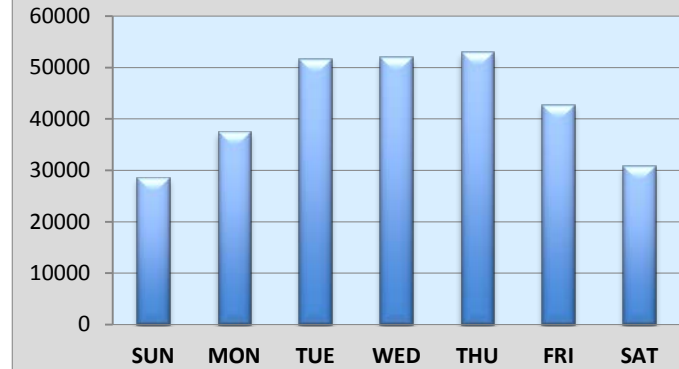
Automatic License Plate Reader Stats
