## **Suspects Caught on Video Breaking into Vehicles**

Between December 24, 2018 and December 29, 2018, twelve (12) vehicles were rummaged through by four suspects. The crimes were caught on surveillance video by residents' security cameras in Seagrass Station and now police need help identifying the suspects.

Various items were stolen from the vehicles all parked in driveways or in front of homes in The Meadows, Southern Oaks, Mill Creek, The Heritage at New Riverside, and Seagrass Station between the dates mentioned above. Police are urging the public to look at the video and contact police if you know who the suspects are and where they can be found. The items taken include guns, wallets, purses, and computers.

"It is the responsibility of all firearm owners to take care of their property. I urge you, if you own a gun, pistol or rifle, please bring it inside and lock it in a safe place inside your home. There is no need for a firearm to be left in a vehicle, especially if that vehicle is unlocked," said Bluffton Police Chief Chris Chapmond.
