Bluffton Safety Day

With warm temperatures and the summer months quickly approaching, more and more boaters will be enjoying Bluffton's scenic waterways. In order to ensure everyone's safety, the Town of Bluffton Police Department and the United States Coast Guard Auxiliary is partnering with local agencies for the third annual Bluffton Safety Day.

Free boat inspections, collection of old boat flares, food, and fun will be available at the event on Saturday, May 18, 2019 from 11 a.m.- 3 p.m. at Oyster Factory Park. The U.S. Coast Guard is scheduled to perform a search and rescue drop in middle of the May River during the event. In addition, there will be non-profit organizations and local businesses in attendance to educate the public about wildlife living in the May River and the vegetation that grows in and around the May River.

The Bluffton Police Department, the Beaufort County Sheriff's Office, the Department of Natural Resources, U.S. Coast Guard, U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary and the Bluffton Township Fire District are all taking part in this event to ensure the public knows the proper steps in staying safe this summer. All of these law enforcement agencies will have boats and vehicles on display.
