Town of Bluffton to Install Street Lights on Boundary Street

The Town of Bluffton will begin installing street lights along Boundary Street in Bluffton's Historic District. Dominion Energy of South Carolina and its subcontractors will begin work in mid-August and the project is scheduled to be completed by early October. The Boundary Street Lighting Enhancement Project will install 12 decorative street lights along Boundary Street and 10 street lights within the park located at 68 Boundary Street. The street lights will match the Shepherd's Crook-style lights used throughout the Historic District.

The project will begin at May River Road and end at Maiden Lane on Boundary Street with street lights alternating from the eastern to the western side of the road. Residents and businesses should expect the increased presence of power company vehicles and employees during construction. Delays should be minimal during construction. Access to all homes and businesses will remain available during the period of installation.

This project is a part of the Town's efforts to provide increased illumination along sidewalks and roadways to improve public safety and walkability within Bluffton's Historic District. The street lights will be lit from dusk until dawn.
